WHAT IS THE CANADA LEARNING BOND?

It's a federal program that grants \$500 into a child's Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP). A child may be eligible for another \$100 per year, up until age 15, depending on the family income (\$2,000 max/child).

Families do not need to put in any of their own money to receive the CLB, but must open an RESP.

To qualify, a child must be born in 2004 or later. The primary caregiver must also receive the National Child Benefit Supplement (aka: "family allowance" or "baby bonus"), under the Canada Child Tax Benefit.
